# Laker Shootout

## Des Lacs High School, Burlington Elementary and Jim Hill Middle School

**Each team is required to prove 1 bench worker to do either score board or score book.**

Please enter and exit the Des Lacs gym using the doors on the east end by the parking lot.

**REGULAR HIGH SCHOOL RULES WILL BE USED, WITH THE EXCEPTION OF CHANGES LISTED BELOW.**

1. Players must compete in their own grade classification, with the exception that players in a lower grade may participate in an older division.
2. All teams must have uniform shirts with visible numbers on back. Numbers are recommended for the front. Dark-soled shoes which leave floor marks are not allowed.
3. 3-Point shot will be used in all divisions if floor is marked.
4. 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th GRADE: **NO ZONE DEFENSE OF ANY KIND ALLOWED** YOU GET ONE WARNING AFTER THAT IT WILL BE A TECHNICAL ASSIGNED TO THE COACH. OFFENSIVELY YOU MUST HAVE ALL 5 PLAYERS AS PART OF YOUR OFFENSIVE SCHEME. EX: YOU MAY NOT HAVE PLAYERS JUST STAND AND NOT BE PART OF THE OFFENSE AND EXPECT THE OTHER TEAM TO HAVE TO GUARD THEM.
5. **Full Court Press is allowed last two (2) minutes of the game only if the score is with 10 points**
6. All team will be guaranteed three games. **FORFEITS ARE COUNTED AS A GAME.** Games will start early when possible. Please have your team at the gym and ready early.
7. We will have **two 18 minutes halves with running clock.**
  - Clock will stop for free throws and timeouts only.
  - **If score is less than 10 points clock will stop during the last two (2) minutes of the game.**
  - Halftime will be 3 minutes.
  - If score becomes 20 points or greater the clock will run on everything except timeouts.
8. Substitution is allowed on dead ball situations only. Defense you may not substitute the last 20 seconds of the first half unless it is on free throws or the offensive team is subbing.
9. Players are allowed five (5) fouls. Teams will shoot the bonus on the 7th foul with two shots on the 10th team foul
10. Teams are allowed **3 timeouts per game.** Overtime will be one (2) minute period with clock stopping as in regular play. Teams will be allowed one timeout during overtime play. If score remains tied after first overtime period, play will move to sudden death. Sudden death will begin with jump ball no timeouts in sudden death.
11. Adult coaches 18 years or older to coach
